Romy Elliott is a contemporary British artist based in London. Through her exploration of anatomy combined with abstract mark-making, she transforms subjects into intimate observations of people and their animal counterparts.

Blurring the lines between painterly abstraction and accurate portrayals, Romy transforms everyday interactions into intimate observations of humans, horses or dogs, in a way that feels entirely contemporary. Pushing the boundaries of anatomy with elongated forms, she focuses on gesture and spontaneous yet intentional mark making. "Sometimes (with the expressionists in mind) I prioritize conveying a feeling, which might involve a stronger commitment to character, expression and line, reducing the emphasis on traditional colour palettes or realism. Other times, I concentrate on light, (impressionists in mind) and will focus on values, tones and temperatures."
