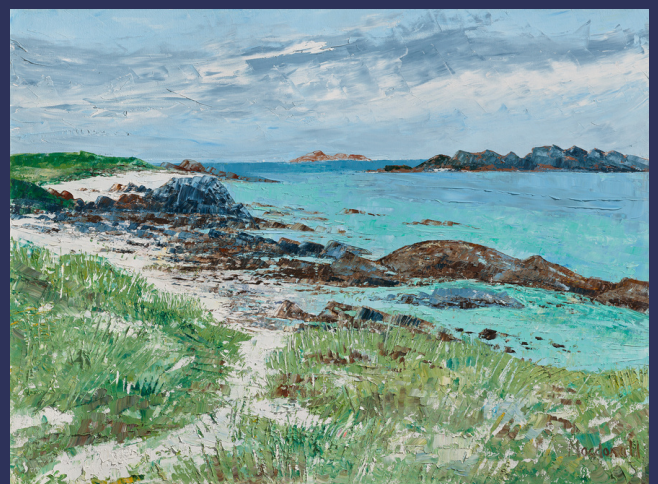
Still Life with Fruit and Roses (circa 1928)
